

Hammond Food Services School Tuck Shop Service Provider

Biometric Data Consent Form

In line with many school tuck shop service providers across the country, Hammond Food Services uses a biometric data system (based upon fingerprint recognition technology) to allow learners to access their tuck shop account. This works by taking measurements of the fingerprint, but does not capture a complete image meaning that the original fingerprint cannot be reconstructed from the data. Biometric data access ensures that learners do not have to use a tuck shop card that could be lost, stolen or left at home.

Hammond Food Services requires the written consent of a Parent/Guardian before we may collect and process the biometric data of any learner.

A tuck shop card may be requested at a cost of R50, as suitable alternative for learner where consent is not given or the fingerprint does not register on the scanner.
